



Questions for the bride contemplating live music for her wedding ceremony

- How would you describe the overall style of your wedding (traditional, modern, off-beat, etc.)?
- How do you envision the part live music will play in your wedding ceremony?
- Will the ceremony be indoors or outdoors? What kind of weather contingency has been planned?
- How much money have you budgeted for ceremony music?
- How much time do you anticipate will be needed for the entire wedding ceremony (from guest arrival and seating to guest departure)?
- Please describe the space where the quintet will perform (include approximate dimensions, if possible).
- Will there be other musicians involved in the ceremony (such as an organist or vocal soloist)?
- Do you have specific selections or a style in mind for the prelude?
 - For the processional?
 - The recessional?
 - The postlude?
- Do you want a solo or some special music as part of the actual ceremony (unity candle lighting, vows, etc.)?
 - If not the quintet, who will perform the solo or special piece?
 - Will the quintet be expected to provide an accompaniment?
 - Do you need to have the selection arranged for the musician(s) who will be performing?
- Will music be needed following the ceremony, but prior to the reception (for a receiving line, for example)?
- Will there be a wedding coordinator on site who will provide cues to the musicians? If so, please provide contact information.
